- Stay online if you can





Invisible: metadata


Visible: OSINT



THE INVISIBLE TRACES WE LEAVE BEHIND

Reducing metadata:

- No real name when registering a device or software such as Libre Office, Adobe Acrobat, etc.
- When publishing contents online change files with lots of metadata (.doc, .jpeg) to other formats (.txt, .png), or use plain text.
- Images: Metanull for Windows
- PDF: Adobe Acrobat XI Pro for Win/Mac, PDF MOD for GNU/Linux
- Firefox add-ons Privacy Badger
- Monitor privacy settings and delete cookies
- Tor will hide specific metadata like our IP address




THE VISIBLE TRACES WE LEAVE BEHIND

Doxxing and Self-Doxxing:

Doxxing (from "Documents", or "Docx"): tracing or gathering information about someone using sources that are freely available on the internet

- Common search engines
- Specific services
- Public forums and mailing lists
- Images
- Whois search



Tips for using social networks

- Check the privacy settings and terms of service
- Check your public profile info
- Don't network with your other identities and with their contacts
- Disable GPS tracking
- Delete metadata from pictures
- Use separate apps for each identity
- Post at different times
- Post about far away events

A credible persona

A virtual persona is not just a name with a mail address and web accounts. Our main traits (gender, job...) can help connect the dotsbetween our fake personas and our true selves.

- Linguistic fingerprint
- Create a character with a story
- Weaknesses, but not your own!
